I do not know if LCCD works correclty if the data is stored in a different folder for each run. And there is also some data that is not correlated to a run, the gas conditions or the environmental conditions for instance. These are written to the data base with a time stamp in regular intervals, no matter if a run is active or not.

For those data that are (or can be) correlated with a run this structure might be good.

I also have some questions:

What does tagging of data mean? Is it something specific for LCCD/CondDBMySQL?
What is location?

Is module the readout module on the end plate? If yes we should not have it in the folder structure but as a data member of the condition.
